

GDPR, Data management and Privacy Policy

St Francis Leprosy Guild (the Guild) takes supporters' privacy and data protection very seriously.

The Guild holds data provided by donors for financial reporting, for management of regular giving and in order to provide reports to donors which is in the legitimate interest of the Guild and would be reasonably expected by the donor.

The Guild does not purchase personal data from other sources nor does it ever pass on personal data to any third party and will not do so unless required by law.

The Guild recognises that all donors and supporters have the right to know what data the Guild holds about them and the Guild will at all times respond speedily and thoroughly with such information.

The Guild holds the data employees have provided for the management of the organisation and as required by HMRC.

GDPR process

In May 2018, the Guild wrote to all donors and supporters seeking their personal consent for the Guild to maintain their data. Any individual who has responded to the effect that they no longer wish to receive communication from the Guild will be marked as such on the database and will not be contacted.
